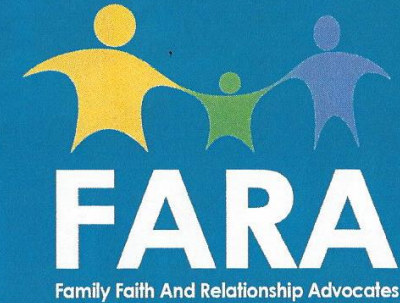

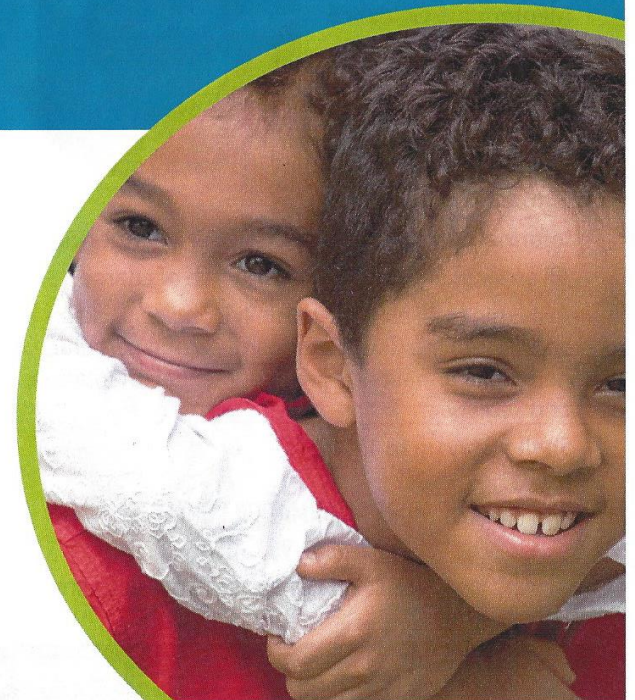

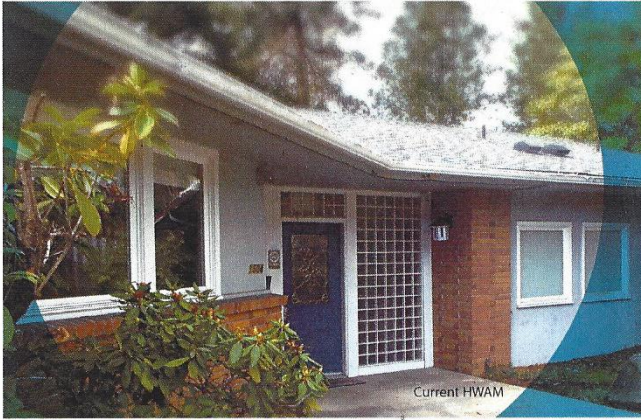
Hearts With A Mission is a faith-based 501(c)3 non-profit and all services provided are confidential and free of charge.

Hearts With A Mission is licensed as a Child Caring Agency by the State of Oregon to provide services for homeless, runaway and transitional youth.

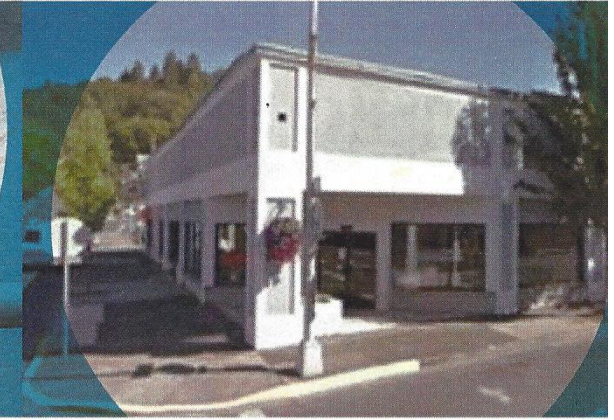

- Licensed by the State of Oregon
- 24/7 Youth Shelter (Ages 10-17)
- Individual Case Management
- Educational and Employment Support
- Mentoring & Guidance
- Life Skills / Recreation
- Nutrition and Meals
- Clothing, Hygiene Products, School Supplies
- Tutoring/Computer Lab
- Information & Referrals to Other Service Agencies
- All services are confidential and free of charge
- Available to all eligible youth in Douglas, Jackson and Josephine Counties regardless of race, color, gender, national origin, religion, sexual orientation, or disability
- Shelter stay up to 120 days

## FARA SERVICES

- Outgrowing Power Anger & Control Program (OPAC), for relationship building and emotional regulation
- Parenting After Crisis Program (PAC), for trauma-informed parenting and relationship skill building
- True Insight Parenting Strategies Program (TIPS) a six-week parenting and relationship series taught via Facebook live
- Safe Families Program, helping families during crisis
- Individual Therapeutic services, Couples Therapy and Family Therapy
